UNIVERSITY PROFILE

INTRODUCTION

Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University was established on 2nd October 1972. This University has been divided into 4 different Universities by the Government of Andhra Pradesh vide A.P. Govt. Act No.30. Namely, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH) located in Kukatpally campus, Hyderabad. Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Anantapur (JNTUA) located in Anantapur campus, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Kakinada (JNTUK) located in Kakinada campus and Jawaharlal Nehru Architecture & Fine Arts University (JNAFAU) located in Masab Tank campus, Hyderabad by A.P. Govt. Act No. 31.

This new University hereafter known as **Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH)** situated in 85 acres campus in Kukatpally, Hyderabad. JNTUH has 2 constituent engineering colleges, one at Hyderabad and the other in Jagityal, Karimnagar, and other constituent units in the campus, conducting UG, PG and Research programs in various disciplines of Engineering, Technology, Sciences and Management. Besides, JNTUH has as many as 420 affiliated colleges spread over the 10 districts of Telangana region of Andhra Pradesh, namely, Adilabad, Hyderabad, Karimnagar, Khammam, Mahaboobnagar, Medak, Nalgonda, Nizamabad, Rangareddy and Warangal.

HISTORY

Under a broad policy framework of providing new technological education required for the industrial growth of the country in general and more particularly for the State of Andhra Pradesh, Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University was established on 2nd October 1972, by an act of State Legislature. Rightly named after the ardent lover of Science and Technology, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India, the University was established with the noble objectives of strengthening and improving the standards of Technological Education and making it relevant to the rural and industrial development of the country. On its formation, the Government Engineering Colleges at Anantapur, Kakinada and Hyderabad, along with the Government College of Fine Arts and Architecture at Hyderabad, became its Constituent Colleges. Subsequently, JNTU act 1972 was amended by JNTU (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992

to affiliate any other college or Institution notified by the A.P. State Government. Hence, JNT University is a Multi - Campus University with Head Quarters at Hyderabad.

In the last thirty three years, JNTU has produced highly professional and competitive Engineers by infusing greater quality and content into the curriculum and educating the students with appropriate skills suitable for a rapidly changing industrial scenario. To improve the Quality of Technological Education, it has participated actively in a number of National Programmes like Teacher Quality Improvement Programme, University-industry-interaction through consultancy, Continuing Education Programmes and Expansion of Infrastructure facilities for Emerging Technologies. Distance Education programmes in B.Tech in Civil, Electrical & Electronics, Mechanical and Electronics & Communication Engineering were started by the University, in the correspondence-cum- contact mode, in 1983 and Computer Science and Engineering was added in 1995. JNT University is also offering through its College of Fine Arts and School of Architecture highly professional and job oriented courses in creative arts, architectural design and planning. University has established a number of higher learning institutes such as Institute of Science and Technology, School of Management Studies. With many professional colleges coming up in private sector, need has arisen to improve the quality of teaching. It necessitates providing continuous refresher courses to the teachers for updating and acquiring additional skills in new areas. With that goal, University has established UGC Academic Staff College for technical teachers which have been sanctioned by UGC.

University is offering a number of P.G. Programmes in Computer Sciences and Information Technology. There are Short Term Courses offered by the University in Software areas. With fast growing needs in the area of IT, University has established School of Information Technology in year 2000-2001 to bring all Computer and IT related activities under the control of School of IT.

The establishment of various Units under JNTU as described above are also shown in Plate under Landmarks of University. To enhance and focus on research, the University has established a Research and Development Cell and provided Scholarships for Full time Research Scholars to increase the member of in-house researchers.

University Vision, Mission & Goals

The objectives of the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad are as follows:

- To provide the advancement of learning and knowledge in Engineering & Technology, Physical & Social Sciences by teaching, training, research and experimentation or practical training or by such other means as the University may deem fit.
- To provide that form of education which allows students to spend periods of intramural work so that upon graduation not only they possess a range of academic learning, but also

the relevance of that learning to the affairs of the State in general and the Country at large.

- To promote
 - thinking on new concepts, techniques, practices in the relevant fields of knowledge and their application to indigenous condition;
 - designing and organising of new courses of study and training, evaluation and examination system;
 - research relevant to the economic growth of the country; entrepreneurship among the students of the Constituent Colleges/ Units; and
 - industrial consultancy services in the different faculties of the Colleges/Units.

Administrative Profile:

The Governor of Andhra Pradesh is the Chancellor of the University. The Vice-Chancellor is the Academic Head and Principal Executive Officer of the University. The Executive Council of the University is the Highest Body mainly concerned with the overall management of the University. Members of this council are drawn from Government, Industry and Academicians from within the University and experts from outside. The Vice-Chancellor of the University is the Chairman of the Executive Council/Monitoring and Development Committee.

Monitoring and Development Committee

For the new JNTUH, till the regular Executive Council of the University is constituted, the transitory body, viz, Monitoring and Development Committee (MDC) has been constituted by the Government of Andhra Pradesh, will be looking after the overall management of the University. The Vice-chancellor is the chairman of the MDC and other members are Chairman, Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education, Principal Secretary to Government, Higher Education Department, Secretary to Government, Finance and Planning Department and Registrar of the University is the member Secretary of the Committee.

Advisory Bodies:

The Executive Council is assisted by Academic Senate, Planning and Monitoring Board, Finance Committee and Selection Committee. The Academic Senate advises the Executive Council on matters relating to the Faculty, Curriculum, and evaluation methods.

Boards of Studies:

Different faculties have Board of Studies headed by a Chairman and Members drawn from academics and industry. There is a provision for Alumni on the Board of Studies. The Director, Academic and Planning is the convenor for all the Boards of Studies of the University. All the decisions of the Boards of Studies will be put to the Academic Senate for its approval.

Planning & Monitoring Board:

The Planning and Monitoring Board shall be the principal planning and reviewing body and it shall also arrange for periodical monitoring of the developmental programmes and teaching and research in the University.

Finance Committee:

The Finance committee advises on all matters relating to the finances and budget of the University.

Selection Committee:

All faculty positions are filled on the recommendations of a duly constituted Selection Committee as per Statutes.

Financial Structure:

The Maintenance grants of the University are received from the Government of Andhra Pradesh. In addition, Department of Science and Technology (DST), University Grants Commission (UGC) and All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) support research and developmental projects. Further the University raises finance through self supporting programmes such as Distance & Continuing Education, P.G. Programmes, Consultancy Services and funded projects.

Academic Courses and Mode of Admission:

The University offers various courses in different faculties leading to the award of Undergraduate, Postgraduate, and Doctoral Degrees.

Undergraduate Programmes:

The University offers the Following Undergraduate Programmes :

- 1) Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.)
- 2) Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm.)

All the above courses of Four Year Duration.

Detailed List of Undergraduate courses being offered by JNTUH is furnished in Tables-1 & 2.

Admission Procedure:

The admission to regular B.Tech. and B.Pharm. Programmes are made based on the merit secured in Engineering, Agricultural and Medical Common Entrance Test (EAMCET) conducted by A.P. State Council for Higher Education. For all the above courses entry level qualifications is 10 + 2.

Similarly, admission to B.Tech (For three year Diploma Holders) is based on the merit secured in the Engineering Common Entrance Test (ECET) conducted by the A.P. State Council for Higher Education. The diploma holders successful in ECET are also eligible for admission into regular B.Tech. courses, at Second Year level. JNTUH conducts an entrance examination of B.Tech. (Correspondence-cum-Contact Course) for admitting employed Diploma Holders of Engineering.

Post graduate Programmes:

The University offers the Following Post graduate Programmes:

- 1) Master of Business Administration (MBA)
- 2) Master of Computer Application (MCA)
- 3) Master of Technology (M.Tech.)
- 4) Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm.)
- 5) Pharm. D Course
- 6) Master of Science (M.Sc.)

All the above programmes are two year duration except MCA which is a Three Year Course.

Admission Procedure:

Admission to MBA and MCA is based on the merit secured in the ICET Examination. Admission to M.Tech. Programmes is based on either GATE or entrance test conducted by the APSCHE (APPGCET). Admission to M.Sc. is based on entrance test conducted by the university. The University conducts Entrance Tests for admission to Continuing and Distance Education programmes in Engineering.

For all the above courses entry level qualifications is Bachelors degree in appropriate field.

Research Programmes:

The University offers the Following Research Programmes:

- 1) Master of Science by Research (M.S.) (In Engg.)
- 2) Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) (In Science & Humanities)
- 3) Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in all disciplines of Engg, Science & Management.

Admission Procedure:

M.S. is a Post Graduate Research Degree in Engineering. Admission for M.S. is through an Entrance Test and an Interview, conducted by the university, for students who possess B.E / B.Tech. or any other Qualifications recognised by the University.

M.Phil. is a research degree offered in Science and Humanities. Admission for candidates possessing Post-graduate qualification is through an interview. The Candidates once admitted, must pass in two subjects prescribed and then submit the thesis based on the results of their research work.

Ph.D. Programme is offered in all faculties. Admission is for candidates possessing Post-graduate qualifications in the concerned subject and is through a Written Test or an Interview or both. The admitted candidates must pass the Pre-Ph.D. Examination in two subjects and then submit the thesis based on the resulting of their research work.

The University has provision for Full Time Internal and Part Time External Registration for Research Programmes. The Full Time Research Scholar has to work in one of the constituent Units of JNTUH. In case of external registration, the candidate must be employed in any research and development organisation or educational institutions having facilities for carrying out the research at their work place. However, they are also permitted to utilise the University facilities when ever required. The external candidate must choose one research supervisor, an expert in his research field.

All admissions for the Academic Programmes of the University are State-wide and are made as per the provisions of the Presidential Order and rule of reservation of AP State Government.

Collaborative Programmes:

Besides these Programmes University conducts Collaborative Programmes with various industries and Universities in India and abroad. The details of such programmes are furnished in Table - 4.

About Constituent Colleges and Units

Constituent Engineering Colleges :

There are two Constituent Engineering Colleges of JNTUH

1. JNTUH College of Engineering Hyderabad (CEH)
2. JNTUH College of Engineering, Jagityal, Karimnagar (CEJ)

Administrative Structure:

Each constituent college has the following administrative structure. The Principal is the administrative and the academic Head of the College. Each department will be headed by a Head of the Department. Head will monitor the academic and developmental activities of the department. The principal is assisted by the Vice-Principal and heads of the departments. Further the Principal is also assisted by the College Academic Committee in academic matters and the Deputy Registrar and the office staff in administrative matters.

Facilities to Staff and Students:

The day-to-day activities of the college are carried out by budgetary allocation from the University funds. Colleges also receive grants from funding agencies such as UGC, AICTE and DST. Besides conducting academic programmes, these colleges offers consultancy services, to various government and private organisation, in various field of Engineering and technology. The colleges have on campus accommodation facilities for students and staff and facilities such as Bank, Post office, Health Centre. The colleges have central library besides this central library majority of the departments have department libraries. Students are encouraged to register and participate in important Profession organisations such as I EEE, ISTE, IETE. Campus placement is very encouraging in JNTUH Engg. college Hyderabad. Over 80% of the students will be placed through campus recruitment in very reputed organisation with attractive pay packages.

In the following paragraphs more specific details of each of these colleges are furnished in brief.

JNTUH COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, HYDERABAD

This College was established as Nagarjuna Sagar Engineering College in 1965 by the Government of Andhra Pradesh. The College was initially under the administrative control of the Department of Technical Education, and affiliated to Osmania University, Hyderabad. With the formation of Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University in 1972, it became a constituent college of the University and was renamed as JNTU College of Engineering, Hyderabad. After being located in temporary buildings, the college was shifted to a hundred acre site at Kukatpally, on the Bombay Highway in 1984 which also houses the main campus of the University. Hyderabad is the Capital of Andhra Pradesh with a population of over 1 crore and is well connected with Air, Train and Bus. The city is over 400 year old with historic monuments as tourist's attraction.

The Industrial Consultancy Unit of the college is very active in offering the expertise of the staff in various fields such as Structural Engineering, Geotechnical Engineering, Survey, and Electrical Engineering. The college presently has three boys hostels and two Girls Hostel. The college provides Hostel facilities for about 800 boys and 530 girls.

There is a University Guest house with 30 rooms to accommodate guests and invitees. The guest house has attached dining hall.

The college, in addition to, regular departments has three research centres viz. Centre for Energy Studies, Centre for Transportation Engineering and Centre for Geo-Environmental Engineering.

Centre for Energy Studies:

The activities of this centre include offering Master and research Programme in Energy studies, building up of a consultancy cell for energy effectiveness and constituting an Energy Management Group consisting of faculty members drawn from the faculties of Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Industrial Engineering. R&D activities are taken up in areas of technologies related to Bio-gas, Solar Energy Automation and alternative fuels. This centre offers M.Tech.(Energy Systems) on both full time & part time basis.

Centre for Transportation Engineering:

The activities of this centre include offering Master Programme and conducting research in the field of Transportation Engineering. Further, the centre offer consultancy services to various organisations and conducts training programmes in the field Transportation Engineering.

Centre for Geo-Environmental Engineering:

The activities of the Centre includes of M.Tech./M.S. and research programme in Geo-environmental Engineering. It also offers consultancy services.

EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION DEPARTMENT

The Examination Branch is consisting of Director of Evaluation, Controller of Examinations, assisted by Additional Controllers of Examinations, Co-ordinators, Advisors and other staff.

Examination system

The University has evolved a system of examination and evaluation procedure which is transparent and automated. The important feature of the examinations system include

1. Encrypted mid term Examination.
2. Electronic Distribution of Examination Question papers.
3. Double valuation system.

Encrypted mid term Examination :

The continuous evaluations of the students are made through the Internal examinations. According to the examination procedure, the internal examination will be conducted simultaneously in all colleges affiliated to JNTUH. Each mid term Examination consists of (i) Objective type Test (for a maximum of 20 marks) of 20 minutes duration, containing multiple choice questions, fill-in the blanks and true or false and match the following type. (ii) Subjective type Test (for a maximum of 20 marks) of 90 minutes duration, with 6 questions-out of which the student has to answer 4 questions.

The quiz paper for each subject shall be prepared in four sets containing different questions in each set. The four sets of quiz papers shall be supplied to the colleges in encrypted form 3 days before the commencement of the mid term examinations. These papers are to be decrypted at the college by receiving a password on the day of examination. The four sets of papers are to be distributed sequentially with the starting set number supplied by the University.

The conventional subjective type question paper shall be prepared by the college and conducted for 90 minutes duration for 20 marks. However the question bank for the subjective type questions for each subject would be made available to the college in the examination portal. The subject teacher shall set the question paper making use of the question bank.

Both objective and subjective tests are to be conducted sequentially with quiz first followed by subjective papers. The papers are to be evaluated and the marks are to be uploaded to the university within four working days after last examination day after reconciliation with the students. These procedures of evaluating students bring uniformity in evaluation and accelerate the evaluation process.

Electronic Distribution of Examination Question papers :

The end examinations in all affiliated colleges shall be conducted by the University examination branch through its Nodal centres. Process of distribution of these question papers, maintaining the confidentiality and protecting them in transit is very important. Any mistake in this process leads to dislocation of the examination in hundreds of examination centres and creates inconvenience to thousands of students. To overcome these difficulties the University has evolved the procedure of Electronic Distribution of examination papers. In this procedure the question papers are randomly generated by the computers in encrypted form. The relevant encrypted question papers(day-wise) will be uploaded through internet, in advance, before commencement of the examinations. The respective colleges have to copy those encrypted question papers into the “Examination Computer System”. The pass-word for decryption of question papers will be released through Examination Portal by the University Examination branch, on the day of examination 45 mts. Before commencement of examination. After getting Original copies of each set of Question Paper, the Principal should make necessary arrangements to prepare sufficient number of photo-copies of question papers. The sets (1,2,3 and 4) of the

question paper are to be arranged in such a way to match the distribution of the question papers as per EAMCET pattern.

Double Valuation System :

In order to make evaluation system perfect and to do justice to all the students, “Double valuation” system is introduced with effect from November, 2005 for all students studying in affiliated engineering colleges. According to this procedure each answer book will be evaluated independently by two examiners. These examiners will award the marks on different award lists. These two award lists will be compared by the Chief Examiner of the subject. If the difference between these two valuations is within the prescribed limits, the higher marks will be awarded to the student. If the differences are more than the prescribed limit the Chief Examiner will finalize the marks in consultation with the two examiners. The above examination procedure, make the foolproof examination and justified.

UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

The University library is located in the main campus with 3 floor of 45,000 sft. Area. Which caters to the need of JNTUH College of Engineering- Hyderabad, Institute of Science and Technology, School of Information Technology, Academic Staff College and School of Management Studies. The University library was fully automated with VTLS – Virtua library software.

The University Library provides special services like Current Awareness Services, Selective Dissemination Information Services, Indexing and Abstracting along with the normal services such as Reference and Referral, Literature Searching, Bibliographic Data, On line Searching, Photo Coping Services, Sc/St Book Bank Services, Digital Library Services, OPAC services, and 24/7 services.

The University Library has over 80,674 books and is subscribing 120 (National and International) technical journals with various subject fields. The library also subscribes abstracts of 120 Journals with national Center for Science Information – IISc, Bangalore under COPSAT services through INFLIBNET. The digital library with E-Books – 1687, E-learning Materials and E-journals – 4328 are available.

The library has a Audio – Visual Library with two colour TVs and VCR with a small number of Video Tapes on various subject fields. The library received grants in-aid from AICTE, UGC, UDF and Plans to purchase more sophisticated computers and develop network facility to all the schools in the campus. The library has Internet Facility with 2mbps leased line, Edusat, Mana TVs programmes, 24/7 facilities are available.

The University library is in the process of creating and maintain a computerized database in the subject fields of Sciences, Engineering, Technology and Management to meet the in – house needs as well as to extend the library services to the industry in twin cities and there by developing a congenial atmosphere for interaction between university and industry. Based on the data collected from the graduates of a year, the facilities for technical education in the institutions for the next academic year and the stock of engineers and the establishment in the corresponding financial year, Technical Manpower Reviews are prepared for overlapping three year periods. These Reviews will be prepared and sent to the lead centre.

The Nodal Centre is headed by a Director Academic and Planning and supported by a Project Officer, Research Associate and supporting staff including field officers and office staff.

PROGRAM INTERFACE UNIT

The University has established a Programmes Interface Unit in the month of August, 1997.

The co-ordinator shall be the Head of the Unit and shall report the matters relating to the activities of the unit directly to the Registrar. Presently the following four activities are being administered by the unit :

Grievances Redressal Cell :

The University has established grievances Redressal Cell which examines the complaints and suggestions received from students staff of various units of the university. The activities of the cell will be monitored by a director. A committee is formulated with senior staff both teaching and non-teaching staff. The committee consists of both male and female members.

SC / ST Welfare :

The University has established a Scheduled Cast and Scheduled Tribes (SC/ST) cell to look after the various programmes relating to the welfare of the employees and students of the University belonging to SC/ST Categories. Accordingly the SC/ST looks after welfare activities and furnish various statistical information of the SC/ST staff and students of the university and affiliated colleges to State Government, Government of India, UGC, and AICTE from time to time.

Career Advancement and Resource Development (CARD) :

In pursuance of the national social policy as enshrined in the Constitution, a Centre for Career Advancement and Resource Development which is now under the Programmes Interface Unit was started by the University in 1989 for SC and ST candidates for providing guidance towards advanced study opportunities and preparing them for State/ National level competitive examinations/tests such as GATE, IES, ECET and EAMCET with financial assistance of Social and Tribal Welfare Department of the Government of Andhra Pradesh and Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The National Service Scheme has been launched with the objective of providing young students with opportunities to devote their spare time in the service of the community around them and of the Nation. This scheme is intended to involve College and University student's in a variety of Social Service and developmental activities without deviating from their main academic programme. This scheme is also intended to make the youth in the colleges aware of social realities and dignity of labour and make them self-reliant and socially responsible. Through various activities like Artisan training courses, afforestation, laying of roads, famine and cyclone relief work, the NSS volunteers are trying to realise these objectives. Established in the year 1974 with the intention of achieving the said goals, the NSS Units of the constituent colleges in JNTU have been very active throughout. At present, there are seventy NSS Units, working with a sanctioned strength of 7000 NSS volunteers, in various constituent Colleges/Units. Each unit is headed by a Programme Officer. To co-ordinate these activities, there is an NSS Cell at the University headquarters headed by a Programme Coordinator. Over the years, the University has played a distinctive role in identifying and executing various

projects under NSS which reflect the specialised nature of the faculties of Engineering, Architecture, Fine Arts and other applied science in the University. 3. To conduct research work and survey for identifying entrepreneurial opportunities (Particularly in S&T areas and service sector).

4. To guide and assist prospective entrepreneurs on various aspects such as preparing project reports, obtaining, project approvals, loans and facilities from agencies of support system, information on technologies.
5. To organize guest lectures, TV & Radio talks, Seminars, etc. for promotion and growth of S&T based entrepreneurship.
6. To arrange visits to industries for prospective entrepreneurs.
7. To extend necessary guidance and escort services to the trainees in obtaining approval and execution of their projects.
8. To act as a Regional Information Centre on business opportunities, processes, technologies, market, etc. by creating and maintaining relevant data bases.
9. To provide testing, calibration, quality assurance, design, tool room, pilot plant and other facilities for entrepreneurs besides expertise in intellectual property rights, patents search, etc.
10. To render advice to sick enterprises and assist the entrepreneurs in rehabilitating them.
11. To conduct skill development training programmes leading to self/wage employment.
